Don Bosco College, Tura - Admission Reservation Policy

- 1. Don Bosco College, Tura recognizes the importance of providing equal opportunities to students from different communities and backgrounds.
- 2. The College will reserve certain percentage of seats for students belonging to Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), other categories, as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Meghalaya.
- 3. In case the reserved seats for SCs and/orother reserved categories are not filled up, the college will allot those reserved seats to ST students, since Meghalaya is a tribal state, and a significant number of ST students apply for admission.
- 4. The College will ensure that the admission process for reserved category students is fair and transparent, and no discrimination is made based on caste, religion, or gender.
- 5. The College will provide adequate support and guidance to reserved category students to ensure their academic success and holistic development.
- 6. The College will also strive to create an inclusive and diverse learning environment that promote mutual respect, understanding, and cooperation among students from different backgrounds.
- 7. The College will regularly review and assess the effectiveness of the reservation policy and make necessary modifications if required.
- 8. This policy has been approved by the Governing Body of Don Bosco College, Tura and shall come into effect from the Academic Year 2020-2021.

This **Admission Reservation Policy** will be implemented in compliance with the guidelines issued by the Government of Meghalaya and will be subject to periodic review and evaluation by the Governing Body of the College.
