
ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK



An effort was made to receive feedback from the 4th and 6th-semester students of the department. For this purpose, a google form was created and sent to students. In order to analyse and represent the data collected, useful statistical tools like percentages, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, graphs have been used.


The college is affiliated with North Eastern Hill University Shillong. It follows the curriculum and syllabus prescribed by the university. In order to analyze the student responses on the curriculum aspect, various questions were asked and responses were collected from the students. Each one of them is explained below.




The chart describes the responses of the students on whether the curriculum is designed to enhance employability. It is observed that 62% of the students agree. About 19% of the students strongly agree. Only 3% of the students strongly disagree that the curriculum is designed to enhance employability.





It can be observed that 54% of the students agree. About 21% of the students strongly agree and only 2% of the students strongly disagree.


















Amenities and Assistance provided at the college.

















About 33%, 35% and 27% of the students say that the classroom infrastructure is excellent, very good and good respectively. With regard to the drinking water facility, 46% of the students say that it is good. About 22% and 21% of the students opined that the drinking water facility is excellent and very good respectively. Around 43%, 22% and 21% of the students opined that washroom cleanliness and maintenance are good, excellent and very good respectively. The majority of the students (62%) say that the greenery on the college campus is excellent. About 52% of the students opined that the cleanliness and maintenance of the college are excellent, 35% says it is very good and 11% good. With regard to canteen facilities, 38% of the students say that it is good, 21% say that it is very good and 19% say it is excellent. About 35%, 32% and 27% of the students opined that the equipment, amenities and assistance for sports activities are very good, excellent and good respectively.
