1. Answer any *five* of the following : $6 \times 5 = 30$.

(a) Who is Helena Charles? What is her relationship with Jimmy Porter?

(b) "He and his brother are like plum trees that grow crooked over standing pools." To whom is Bosola referring, and why does he make this comparison?

(c) What, according to her prosecutors, is Joan's crime? What is the sentence meted out to her?

- (d) Why did Ferneze confiscate Barabas' wealth and turn his house into a convent? How did Barabas use Abigail to recover his gold?
- (e) Why is Sir Sampson Legend upset with his son, Valentine? How does he intend to punish him?
- (f) Briefly describe the practical joke played by Sir Toby and Maria on Malvolio.
2. "Barabas is both the oppressed and the oppressor, victim and villain." Describe this duality in the character of Barabas.
3. Examine the relationship between Jimmy and Alison in *Look Back in Anger*.

6. How does the Duchess of Malfi face her death? What does this reveal of her character?
